79 letters were sent out as correction notices. \$725 of fines was assessed. \$325.00 was forgiven due to special circumstances. Late fees assessed were \$200.00.

#### **Storm Sewer Maintenance Update**

The filter vaults were inspected in August of 2018 and are in compliance. The filter will be inspected in 2019 spring and replaced if needed in 2019.

### 2018 Proposed Budget Review & Vote

Dues were increased from \$325 in 2018 to \$350.00 in 2019.

Board approved budget for 2019

Payments will be split again this year with first installment dues January 2019 Second installment due in March 2019

Notices will go out in late December to owners and 200.00 will be required for first payment if they are split.

# Parking Issues on 71st and 85th ave

School buses have issues with getting up the hill and turning around. Letters were sent out to owners about vehicles on the street.
